LOCATION AND SOIL

Saint-Seurin is located in the canton of Pauillac, the AOC zone of Haut-Médoc, borders on the commune of Saint-Estèphe to the south, running along the river.

The castle is one of the oldest in the Medoc, overlooks the estuary, is a beautiful example of the eclectic 19th-century architectural style.

It is surrounded by vines planted on gravel soils, giving the wine a touch of magic.
